SUBJECT: TRANSIT PLAN – MOBILITY MANAGEMENT – COORDINATION PLAN

At present, CAG is providing Mobility Management for the Sun Corridor MPO, to include developing the required Coordination Plan, and hosting required coordination meetings. Sun Corridor MPO has not been a stakeholder in developing the CAG Coordination Plan, nor have we participated in the coordination meetings.

The upcoming Transit Implementation Plan will include all required coordination activities for the Sun Corridor MPO. In the scope of work, in addition to the implementation plan, we will include the development of the federally required Sun Corridor Transit Transportation Human Services Coordination Plan, and structure and schedule bi-monthly coordination meetings with all transit providers within the MPO planning boundaries. We hope to coordinate with CAG on these activities.

We anticipate the RFP for the Transit Implementation Plan to be ready to advertise by August/September 2014.

The Transit Implementation Plan may cover some of these activities:

- Determining 5307 Public Transit within the MPO boundaries
- Determining the 5311 (Coolidge) future structure and service within the MPO
- Developing the 5310 Elderly and Disabled program within the MPO
- Addressing all modes of transportation; air, rail, ride-share, etc.
- Research funding opportunities
- Addressing Air Quality issues through transit opportunities (there is funding!)
- Develop the required Coordination Plan

We would like to develop a technical advisory committee in July to determine the scope of the transit implementation plan. We encourage anyone who is interested to volunteer.

SUBJECT: Consultation on Conformity Assessment for SCMPO Projects

The Sun Corridor MPO will provide information to individuals for consultation and to provide technical assistance for new projects being placed on the TIP, and to review amendments to the TIP. They will review all changes to projects prior to the TIP being submitted to ADOT for review and processing.

The purpose is to ensure all projects meet conformity standards. The group of advisors at a minimum, can be made up of SCMPO TAC members; Casa Grande, Coolidge, Eloy, ADOT and Pinal County, along with a representative from local and regional transit agencies. ADOT transit section, FTA, FHWA, ADEQ, and MAG.

Information will be receive in a memo outlining the changes to the TIP at least one week prior to our regularly scheduled TAC meeting, allowing the TAC to approve the TIP changes and submit the TIP to the Executive Board for approval, based upon comments from the advisors.

MAG has offered to provide training on the responsibilities of consultation and how they will work toward determining the conformity assessment for projects. We would like for MAG to provide this training at our July meeting.

At present, MAG is reviewing our TIP for accuracy, and ensuring we do not trigger a conformity assessment on any given project because of inaccurate information.

SUBJECT: Changes made to TIP Amendment #1

MAG reviewed our TIP Amendment #1, and found there were a few errors that would have triggered a conformity finding:

- Casa Grande's Henness / I-8 project was moved from 2035 to 2018, requested by the project sponsors consultant. Unfortunately the project was modeled for construction in 2035. We needed to move this project back to 2035, and when a modeling schedule is determined by MAG, this project will be re-modeled to move the construction date up.
- Coolidge's Central Avenue project had incorrect information in the lanes before and lanes after, and the length of the project. This was corrected.

We were able to request FHWA not approve our TIP amendment #1, and re-submitted the corrected TIP to ADOT, with a memo outlining the changes.

As well, there were typo's on the Coolidge Central Avenue project, that were corrected: Lanes before/after is two (2) not four (4); length is .4 miles not 1 mile.

SUBJECT: Possible STP project development/design Project

At present the Sun Corridor MPO does not have any future STP projects identified that could step in if a project needs to move to another year, or if funding becomes available.

- We have sent notification out to the other COG/MPO's that the SCMPO has \$581,161 in 2016 STP funds available to lend out, with a pay back on October 1, 2016 for the 2017 Coolidge Main Street project.
- We only need \$252,000 to be paid back in 2017 and the remainder (\$329,661) to be paid back in 2018. This amount will cover the Eloy Main Street Construction project.
- We do not have any projects programmed for 2019 forward.

Sun Corridor staff recommends that we request a call for STP projects as soon as possible, in order to have a development/design project identified as a backup should any existing project not make their project due date, or if additional funding becomes available.

We suggest a call for STP projects to be announced for August. This will at least identify a potential project as a backup.
