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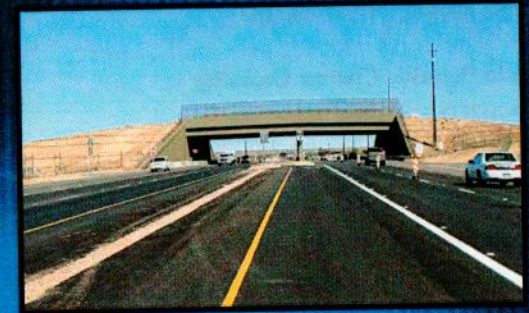

Project goals

- Objective, comprehensive evaluation of those public transit services operating within Coolidge as well as surrounding Pinal County
- “Blueprint” for continued service development
- Identify potential service funding opportunities
- Options of CART for future governance

Cotton Express

- Deviated fixed-route bus service operating along two routes within Coolidge
- Curb-to-curb service is provided via route deviations for seniors and persons with disabilities
- Operates weekdays from 6:45 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Central Arizona Regional Transit (CART)

- Weekday service from 5:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. linking Casa Grande, Coolidge, and Florence
- Key trip generators: Casa Grande Regional Medical Center, Central Arizona College, and Pinal County complex
- Jointly funded by Central Arizona College, Coolidge, Florence, Pinal County, and ADOT

Project methodology

- Evaluate Cotton Express and CART services through ride checks, rider survey, and consultant field observations
- Identify and quantify current and future demand for public transit service
- Reach consensus as to future service needs and priorities
- Present “phased” approach to program development

Community engagement

- Community survey: Mailed to 1,500 households *12%*
- Stakeholder roundtables: Casa Grande, Coolidge, and Florence
- Mobile outreach: 10 locations
- Interactive project webpage *updated weekly* *online comment form*

Coolidge: public feedback

- Trial Saturday service
- Increase transit marketing/outreach
- Introduce service to...
 - Imagine Charter School
 - Central Arizona Valley Institute of Technology

CART: public feedback

- More frequent service (weekdays)
- Trial service on Saturday
- Increase transit marketing/outreach
- Express/peak-hour (weekday) service to key employer sites in Casa Grande *Abbott, Chamber, Frito Lay, Banner*
- Introduce service to...
 - San Tan Valley
 - Eleven Mile Corner Road
 - Arizona City
 - Florence - Anthem and Florence Gardens

Additional public input

- Establish local circulators in Casa Grande and Florence
- Develop partnership with larger employers in Casa Grande (to support express/peak-hour service)
- Pursue partnership with Gila River Indian Community

Recommendations: Coolidge

- **Phase 1:**
 - Formalize route-deviation policy
 - Provide bi-directional service along Arizona Boulevard
- **Phase 2:** *2-3 years*
 - Introduce limited-hour Saturday service on a trial basis

Recommendations: CART

- **Phase 1:** *18 months*
 - Local circulator in Florence
 - Increase service frequency along the trunk line (service from Florence to Coolidge, and Coolidge to Central Arizona College)
 - Extend service to Florence Gardens and Florence Anthem Hospital
 - Extend service to Eleven Mile Corner Road (*county housing*)
- **Phase 2:**
 - Extend service to San Tan Valley
 - Extend service to Sacaton and Blackwater
 - Extend service to Arizona City
 - Extend service to Eloy
