^{County} Pinal Regional Transit Governance Study Update - Agenda Item #9

- May 1, 2019 – Request for Proposal is scheduled to be issued.
- June 12, 2019 – Request for Proposals are due.
- July 31, 2019 – Notice to Proceed to selected consultant.

Pinal Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) Update - Agenda Item #10

- November 7, 2017 – Pinal County voters approved Propositions 416 (Pinal Regional Transportation Plan) and 417 (County Transportation Excise Tax).
- April 1, 2018 – Tax went into effect.
- November 15, 2018 – Judge ruled that Proposition 417 was void and unenforceable as the tax only extended to retail sales and not all privilege tax categories as required by state statute.
- April 17, 2019 – Board of Supervisors approved the hiring of Patrick Irvine from Fennemore Craig as legal counsel and releasing of Joe Kanefield. Awaiting response from Appellate Court on schedule of hearings or ruling.
- April 19, 2019 – Total revenue in the escrow account is \$15 million.

Pinal County Strategic Transportation Safety Plan Update - Agenda Item #12

- November 30, 2017 – Notice to proceed issued to AMEC Foster Wheeler (Wood) November 30, 2017 with Greenlight Traffic Engineering as the subconsultant.
- April 23, 2019 – Submitted 4 HSIP applications (2 spot location projects in Apache Junction, 1 spot location in San Tan Valley, and 1 countywide systemic project) to the MAG Safety Committee for pre-approval.
- May 3, 2019 – In addition to the above projects, 2 other HSIP applications may be submitted (1 state route spot location and 1 strategic transportation safety plan).
- June 2019 – Public Outreach meetings in Apache Junction, Maricopa, and San Tan Valley
- July-August 2019 – Agency Board-Council-Committee presentations and Final Plan

Pinal County Local Government Project Report - Agenda Item #19

- **Pinal County Sign Upgrade Project, ADOT TRACS SH645 03D/01C**
 - March 2017 – The sign project was awarded to Main Street Signs with a contract start date in March 2017.
 - May 2017 – The kick-off meeting was conducted.
 - December 2017 – ADOT inspected the signs and Pinal County was authorized to install.
 - January 23, 2019 – Pinal County sign crew has completed the installation of 1,638 signs.
 - Last update on project as it is complete.

Tentative 2020- 2024 5-Year Construction Program

The **Tentative 2020-2024 Five Year Facilities Construction Program** was approved by the State Transportation Board on February 15th at the State Transportation Board meeting in Douglas.

The Tentative 5 Year Construction Program was made available via the ADOT website on March 13th (<https://www.azdot.gov/planning/transportation-programming/current-program>).

The Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development, or BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant program, provides a unique opportunity for the DOT to invest in road, rail, transit and port projects that promise to achieve national objectives. Previously known as Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery, or TIGER Discretionary Grants, Congress has dedicated nearly \$7.1 billion for ten rounds of National Infrastructure Investments to fund projects that have a significant local or regional impact.

Applications are now being accepted and must be submitted through [Grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov) *with all other application materials* **by 8:00 PM E.D.T. on July 15, 2019.**

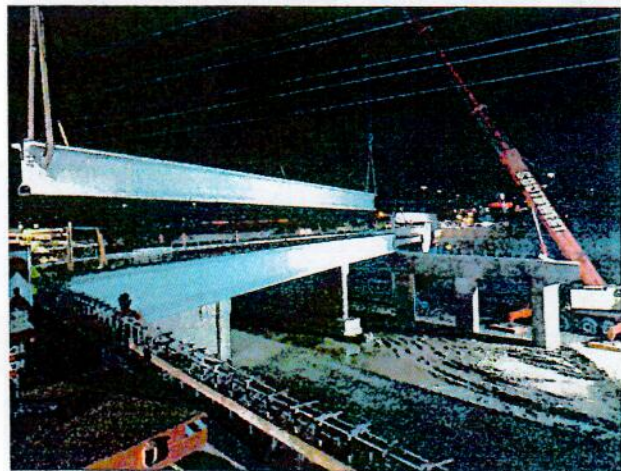

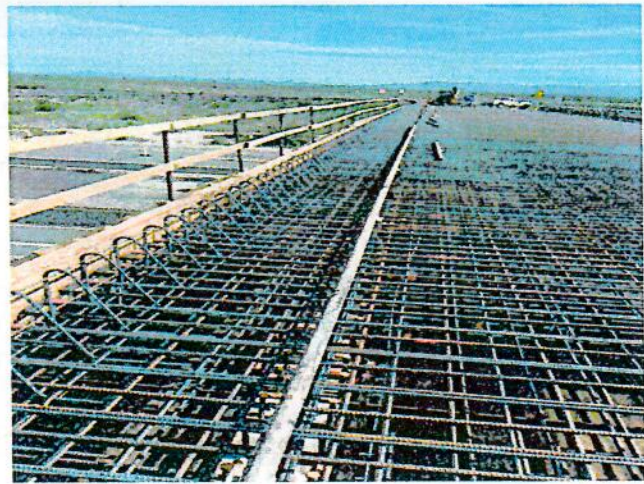

SCMPO Technical Advisory Committee Meeting- MAG Update April 25, 2019

1. Air Quality Conformity Analysis:
 - a. Spring 2019 is currently underway
 - b. Winter 2019 draft schedule is under review; this conformity analysis will include the SCMPO TIP and RTP Update; projects will need to be submitted to MAG by Wednesday August 14
 - c. Spring 2020 schedule is in development
2. MAG TIP- development of the new TIP for FY 19-23 is currently underway
3. MAG RTP Update:
 - a. Interim 2040 RTP Update-
 - i. MAG is currently facilitating an administrative update to our 2040 RTP alongside the update of the TIP. Similar to the 2017 update, no policy or planning changes are anticipated as continues forward the assumptions of Proposition 400 through its funding horizon (2026). This administrative update is intended to provide MAG a full four years—if needed—to produce the new RTP, *Imagine*, reflective of the planning context set with the anticipated extension of Proposition 400.
 - b. *Imagine* RTP, Extension of Prop 400
 - i. Values mapping survey was completed at the beginning of this month; over 9200 completed surveys were received. Currently in data analysis with expected results to be delivered to our policy makers thereafter (tentative: June). This values mapping will help to inform the development of the goals and objectives, as well as identify the priorities of constituents which will be valuable in early policy discussions.
 - ii. A variety of individual study and planning work continues. Enabling legislation discussions will occur with policy makers over the forthcoming months in preparation for the 2020 session whereby MAG will seek to gain authority, like all other counties in the state, for ballot approval from the Board of Supervisors rather than the legislature.
 - iii. We're currently planning on a county vote in November 2022; this would require delivery of the new *Imagine* RTP by the end of 2021 for purposes of air quality conformity. However, by facilitating the interim 2040 RTP update (above) this winter, it allows us the flexibility, if needed, to delay to a November 2024 election date (which would translate to a winter 2023 RTP delivery).
