SUBJECT: Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #25

TIP Amendment #25 is being processed to adjust funding for 5311 preliminary award amounts based on updated Preliminary Notice of Award Year 2 for Cotton Express and CART Operating Expenses, Cotton Express and CART Preventative Maintenance, and Cotton Express and CART Administration (STIP ID: 101749)

This amendment also adds three new 5339 funded transit projects to the TIP for Cotton Express/CART: Replacement Bus, Replacement Maintenance Lift, and Computer Equipment.
