Attendees included representatives from ADOT, MAG, Pinal County, GRIC, Ak-Chin, Maricopa, Apache Junction, Queen Creek, and Sun Corridor member agencies. The group reviewed the study objectives, work plan, schedule, and preliminary crash data. The consultant is working on data collection (signalized intersections).</p> <p>Transportation Alternative (TA) Program - The Sun Corridor MPO TAC Members have been working with MPO staff on identifying TA projects. The following TA projects are being submitted for this call for projects: Casa Grande Safe Routes to School Project Coolidge Safe Routes to School Project Eloy Sidewalk Project</p>	
8	Air Quality (AQ) Update (Information Only)	
	<p><i>Jason Botljen provided the following update for Pinal County:</i></p> <p>Pinal County Update - Anu Jain has been named Interim Director of Air Quality as the County works to fill the position. Anu, the Air Quality Permitting Manager, has been with the department since 2002. On July 21, 2023 the EPA published a final rule to determine that the West Pinal County PM-10 Nonattainment Area failed to attain the primary PM-10 NAAQS by the statutory attainment date. A Five Percent Plan for PM-10 for the West Pinal County Nonattainment Area. MAG, Pinal County, ADEQ, ADOT and SCMPO are working together to develop the Five Percent Plan. The Clean Air Act deadline for submittal of a five percent plan is December 31, 2023.</p> <p>SCMPO Spring 2023 Air Quality Conformity - The Conclusion of Consultation Notice was sent out on June 28, 2023. The Request of a Finding of Conformity was submitted to FHWA and FTA on June 28, 2023. SCMPO, MAG, FHWA, and the EPA are still working through additional comments submitted by the EPA. The Finding of Conformity will be on hold until all comments have been addressed.</p> <p>SCMPO Winter 2023 Air Quality Conformity - The Winter 2023 Air Quality Project List was submitted to MAG on August 10, 2023. Approval to Advertise the Winter 2023 Air Quality Project List and Conformity Analysis for 30-Day Public Review and Comment Period which is tentatively scheduled for November 9, 2023, through December 9, 2023, is part of today's consent agenda.</p>

	<p><i>Will Randolph provided the following update:</i></p> <p>FY25-29 Five Year Construction Program: District workshops are currently ongoing and will conclude in the month of September. The P2P process will prioritize all highway construction projects for consideration in ADOT's FY 2025-2029 Five Year Construction Program.</p> <p>ADOT SMART Program: Please continue to work with your local agencies to submit any applications for the SMART program. The website continues to be host of useful information found at https://azdot.gov/planning/grant-coordination/az-smart-fund.</p> <p>Federal Discretionary Grants: Please continue to visit USDOT's website or the ADOT grant coordination page https://azdot.gov/planning/adot-grant-coordination-group for the NOFOs and deadlines.</p> <p>TA Program: Project applications were accepted up to August 31st for phase 1 of the process. Project sponsors whose application met the phase 1 screening criteria were/will be invited by email to apply to the phase 2 evaluation process. Project sponsors will need to submit their Phase 2 evaluation applications before the September 29, 2023 deadline. The program website is live at https://activetransportation.az.gov/transportation-alternatives-program. The website has a recorded webinar, guidance, FAQs, links to the application and more.</p> <p>ADOT studies:</p> <p>Long Range Transportation Plan: The LRTP has finished the first public review for the Draft LRTP for the 45 day comment period, the deadline was September 7th. For the review of the draft LRTP we received over 111 responses and 485 individual comments. In addition, at the 8/22/23 Statewide Virtual Meeting, 67 people attended and submitted 73 comments and questions. Comments will be addressed in the plan and a revised draft will go to the Governor's Office, ADOT Executive Leadership and the STB in September. Then, a final 30 day public comment period will occur before it goes to the STB for final approval in October. Please visit the ADOT LRTP webpage https://www.ado2050plan.com which hosts the plan documentation, summary sheets (2-3 page bullet point reports of said working papers) and to provide comments.</p> <p>Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Plan: The NEVI plan update was submitted on August 1st with approval expected by September 30th as required per the Joint Office of Energy and Transportation. A Statewide Virtual Public Meeting for the EV Plan Update took place on 7/18/23. The Request for Information period has closed to gain feedback and perspectives for the future procurement of vendors regarding the EV installation and we are reviewing the responses received. ADOT will be looking at conducting RFPs the later part of this year or into 2024. For more information visit our EV plan website, and feel free to sign up to the mailing list to receive study updates by email and opportunities to provide input. https://azdot.gov/planning/transportation-studies/arizona-electric-vehicle-program</p> <p>Statewide Truck Parking Plan: The last stakeholder meeting occurred on September 11th and the project is on schedule. The recent stakeholder meeting discussed the undesignated parking analysis, locations of improvement, and implementation strategies. The consultant is also working on a benefit/cost analysis, alternative materials, and locations for potential truck parking expansions/conversions at existing ADOT facilities.</p> <p>Statewide ITS Architecture Update: The data collection is completed but the PMT team will continue to accept any local agencies inventory and need surveys. The prior 2018 project lists have also been sent to local agencies for any updates to be implemented in the updated project list.</p>

The low bid was FNF Construction. Construction to start in November 2023. • SR87 at Kenworthy/SR287 at Christensen - Add turn lanes. Bid open September 15, 2023. • SR387 from SR87 to SR187 Pavement Preservation awarded to Nesbitt. Construction to start in early 2024. • SR187, SR87/SR387 Shoulder Turn Lanes. Design is underway. Construction summer 2024. • SR87 and Skousen Road - Install turn lanes and Traffic Signal - 90% plans are complete. Construction Spring of 2024. • SR387/I10 TI - ADOT Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSMO) did some additional striping to help with queuing.
