	<p>Casa Grande - Mayor Fitzgibbons stated that the roadway improvements for Trekell Rd are underway. The City will be starting this late summer/fall the roadway improvements on McCartney Rd, from Pinal Avenue to I-10. This project was approved by a bond by the voters. The City did a community survey at the beginning of the year to find out the needs of the public. Infrastructure and roads were critical. The City in the budget this year will be dedicating \$100M towards roads and infrastructure on top of what we have in reserves. We have about \$200M in reserves and will be taking \$16M to go into immediate road improvements and beautification around the City. We have been operating under a 50% reserve and we are reducing that to 30% to use funding for road improvements. Busy year! Chairman Miller asked about Trekell Rd North of McCartney. Duane Eitel stated that the project is also a bonded project. The City is waiting on final estimates on McCartney to make sure there is enough money in the bond to cover the extension of Trekell Rd, North of McCartney to Val Vista. The project is not in the upcoming CIP but in the following year's CIP.</p> <p>City of Coolidge - Mayor Thompson stated that they wanted traffic counts on SR87 from Coolidge to Gilbert Rd. Because every time you drive on this road, especially east back towards Coolidge, it's a mess at certain times of the day with traffic bumper to bumper and traffic going 75 MPH. When there is a wreck on I-10 they move everyone to Signal Peak Rd. Irene Higgs states that there is currently a profile corridor study taking place for SR287/SR87. Traffic counts are part of the study. The project is from SR87, I-10 (Eloy) to Coolidge and from Coolidge to Hunt Highway. It also goes from SR287, Coolidge to Florence. WHEREAS, in accordance with Title VI requirements, the Sun Corridor MPO has developed a Title VI and Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Implementation Plan, the purpose of which is to describe how the Sun Corridor MPO intends to ensure that underserved individuals are provided meaningful opportunities to become involved in the transportation planning process within the Sun Corridor MPO region; and

WHEREAS, FTA Circular 4 702.1 B III-2-3, requires Governing Board approval of Title VI plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sun Corridor MPO Executive Board hereby approves the 2026 Title VI and Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Implementation Plan.
